Progress after 1 month of daily treatment:

There is a notable shrinkage with regard to the visualely affected area of discoloration and intensity in both eyes.

The actual progress appears to be from 1.2 mm to .6 mm at present.

NOTE: I noted Bob does eat the waffer as readily as at first.



Progress after 6 months of treatment

Subjects weight 35.1 lbs.

Only a trace of the initial discoloration is present.

The subject will not eat the tabs with out appling in an indirect method.

Suspect body has become saturated with the critical mineral.

Subject appears to have 99% vision.

The dose rate was cut to a maintenance level.

We have not observed any reoccurring vision issue.
